CONDITIONS

Entrance fees can be paid at the time of entry or on the day of the event.

The competition shall be played in accordance with the rules of Golf as adopted by the Royal and Ancient Club of St Andrews and the United States Golf Association, together with such Local Rules as may be in force on the day at the Romsey Golf Club. If a dispute arises on any point it shall be resolved by the match committee.

The event is open to all women amateurs, who hold a current GA handicap.

In this event competitors will be drawn against each other for the day in such manner as the match committee may arrange.

The Committee shall make all arrangements, and will have full power to alter or vary the conditions should they deem necessary.

The Committee may, in the event of bad weather or for any other reason, shorten, reschedule or cancel the event.

In the event of a tie, the Romsey Women's Open Champion will be decided by a sudden death play off on holes 12 and 18, continuously, in that order. All other events will be decided on a countback as per the Golf Australia Operational Guidance and Supporting Regulations.

Golf Australia standard conditions of entry, including accidents, drugs and personal risk apply.
